### **Project objective**

The main objective of the project is to increase the ability of 100 Third Country Nationals (TCNs), including 75 women and 25 men residing in Lower Silesia, to actively participate in social and professional life from 01.09.2024 to 31.12.2025.

### **Participants**

The target group of the project is 100 persons – Citizens of Third Countries with a preference for citizens/females of Ukraine, who arrived legally to Poland after 24.02.2022 in connection with the Russian aggression against Ukraine and reside (according to the Civil Code) in Lower Silesia. Support within the project is addressed to economically inactive, unemployed as well as employed persons.

### **Tasks**

Support within the Project will be realised through 8 substantive tasks including:

- ❖ Individual meetings with a vocational counsellor and psychologist to identify the individual needs of each Project Participant
- ❖ Interpreter support for Project Participants and their families
- ❖ Integration into the life of the local community, including i.a. comprehensive support concerning the legalisation of stay in Poland or assistance in obtaining documents and dealing with official matters
- ❖ Integration into the Polish community in the area of education and culture
- ❖ Assimilation and adaptation to the social environment – psychological support for adults and children
- ❖ Linguistic support – learning the Polish language
- ❖ Adaptation in society – organisation of integration and cultural events for the Participants
- ❖ Vocational activation – professional courses to improve qualifications

The project assumes that the above-mentioned activities will permanently and effectively improve the professional and social situation of Project Participants, contributing to their better integration in the local community and labour market.

## **Results of project realisation**

### **Increase in professional activity**

The project realisation will contribute to an increase in the professional activity of Participants through support in defining individual paths of professional reintegration and application of active integration services. Participants will gain practical skills and knowledge which will allow them to find their place on the labour market better.

### **Increase in qualifications and competences**

As a result of the project activities, Participants will improve their qualifications and/or competences, which will increase their attractiveness on the labour market. Support will include various forms of training, courses and vocational counselling tailored to the individual needs and predispositions of the Participants.

### **Undertaking employment or continuing education**

The project will also result in an increased number of people undertaking employment or deciding to continue their education through participation in further training and education. Thanks to comprehensive support, participants will be able to achieve their professional and educational goals more effectively.
